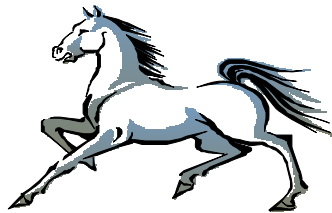
### **Fourth Annual California Masonic Symposium Freemasonry and the American Frontier**
