INTACCT

Last year, our Grand Lodge started developing an accounting and reporting program for use by Lodges and Hall Associations, called "<u>INTACCT</u>". It will take a major load off the backs of the Secretaries and Treasurers in recording and submitting tax and financial data packages for the Government and our Grand Lodge. It is now been tested by more than 50 Lodges and is ready to be implemented in 2013.

You may now enroll in and learn to use Intacct through our Grand Lodge Web Site. A sign-up form is available and (8) pre-recorded training videos are accessible in the "Resources and Publications" section of the secure Web Site. Training sessions (Webinar or one-on-one training with a team member) will be available, and state-wide training events are being planned.

There is a small monthly cost involved, but the benefits to the Lodge and Building organizations and the avoidance of errors and possible non-compliance with regulations appears to be well worth the extra expense.

The Grand Lodge <u>Intacct</u> Team is available by phone at 415-292-9170 if you wish to explore this program further. If you proceed with this system, you will also find more continuing support via an interactive "University", support on evenings and weekends, and quarterly live Webinars starting in March.
