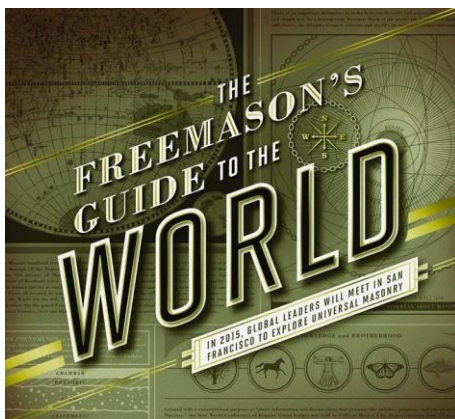
BIG CHANGES IN STORE FOR 2014 GRAND LODGE!
