One of the unusual and interesting activities being offered for all guests at our next Annual Communication is the special program being planned by our Grand Master's wife, Janette Perry, on Saturday afternoon at the Peacock Court in the Mark Hopkins Hotel. Along with an amazing magic show, there will also be a nostalgic walk down memory lane offered by some of our Past Grand Master's wives. And a delicious lunchtime menu will accompany the festivities.



We had excellent results in the first year of our Masonic partnership with the L.A. Dodgers Foundation and its Dodger RBI (Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities) Project, through our fraternity's Masons4Mitts program expansion into southern California. Our second season for this outstanding charity is now in full swing!

Over the past seven years, our Grand Lodge has partnered with major league baseball in California (starting in 2010 with the San Francisco Giants Community Fund) to provide funds for baseball gloves for their youth programs. With another 8,000 mitts donated in 2015, this program has already raised enough money to purchase about 26,000 of these mitts! Every mitt is embossed with the Masons of California logo and square and compass symbol.

At the "Mason's Night" game with the San Francisco Giants on September 19th at Dodger Stadium, our 2016 donation will be presented to the Dodger Organization.

As of the end of July this year, our five L.A. area teams have already raised enough money for approximately 850 mitts (\$17,000). Hopefully, by game time in September, we will be able to add many more mitts to this total!
