SENIOR WARDENS JOIN OUR DEPUTY GRAND MASTER

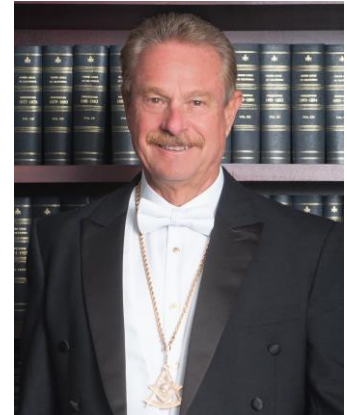
