Belton. He will be joined by Scottish Rite Journal Editor S. Brent Morris, Deputy Grand Master John L. Cooper III, PhD., and Past Grand Master R. Stephen Doan, J.D.

It is open to Masons and the public, with a \$10 charge (plus \$15 for lunch). You are asked to complete a *registration form* found on the Grand Lodge Web Site, under "Masonic Education".
