KEEP MASONIC SCHOLARSHIPS IN MIND

Each year, the California Masonic Foundation and other associated Masonic groups provide educational opportunities for high school graduates and college students through a number of yearly scholarship awards. More than \$1 million scholarship dollars are awarded yearly. In addition, the Fraternity provides a special scholarship program, called "Investment In Success", which helps high school seniors that are under hardships to receive a higher education.

We have also launched the "College Gold Rush" Program, an on-line resource providing assistance in accessing general financial aid, along with the various scholarships. Our third season of partnership with the L.A. Dodgers Foundation and its Dodger RBI (Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities) Project, through our fraternity's Masons4Mitts program expansion into southern California, is now in full swing! We have had excellent results with this outstanding charity here in the Los Angeles area these past two years.

As you know, over the past eight years, our Grand Lodge has partnered with major league baseball in California (starting back in 2010 with the San Francisco Giants Community Fund) to provide funds for baseball gloves and other needs for their youth programs. Every mitt provided is embossed with the Masons of California logo and square and compass symbol.

As of the end of July this year, our five L.A. area teams have already raised enough money for approximately 500 mitts (\$10,000) for the Dodger youth. With your help and enthusiasm the next two months, by game time in September, we should be able to more than double this mitt count!

At the "Mason's Night" game with the San Diego Padres on September 27th at Dodger Stadium, this year's donation will be presented to the Dodger Organization. Get game tickets from your Lodge. Be at Dodger Stadium for the results! And again in 2017, celebrate bringing baseball to California kids one mitt at a time!
